Also, my total aid package, including all scholarships cannot exceed the cost of attendance. The University of Central Florida reserves the right to adjust this scholarship to comply with the above University policy.
- I will be granted priority registration starting the spring semester after starting LEAD Scholars so that I may enroll in LDR courses in a timely manner.
